Overview

Grants must be executed on schedule, subawards must be managed consistently, and documentation must withstand ongoing review.

Grant Program Reality for States

Grant Execution & Administration

How States Can Contract Monterey

Monterey is an awarded vendor under the NASPO ValuePoint Procurement of Acquisition Support Services PASS contract, which is available for use by participating states. This contract may be used to support grant execution, subaward management, and related program support services.

Additional state-specific procurement options may be available depending on jurisdiction.
