QTC QUALITY NUMBERS

When giving exams to our veterans, quality and timeliness are of the utmost importance. To ensure quality performance here are some valuable points to keep in mind:



Remind veterans to complete surveys on your behalf.



Provide examples, such as screenshots/case numbers, on issues you would like to follow up on.



To avoid missing any pending reports or addendums be sure to check your provider portal daily.



Visit the E-Learning Center in the provider portal for any updates, training, or helpful tips.

Check emails (junk/spam included) daily for any communications from QTC or Monterey.

Be proactive- to avoid scheduling interruptions, please ensure malpractice insurance or licensing is not expired. You are to handle expiring insurance or licensure accordingly.

WEEKEND TRAVEL OPPORTUNITIES Providers Needed!

We are seeking providers [Physicians, Nurse Practitioners, Physicians Assistants, Audiologists, and Optometrists] who can travel for weekend events [typically one day only]. You will be responsible for conducting annual physicals. This is a great opportunity for you to give back to and spend the day with our reservist service members. Additionally, you will be reimbursed at a daily rate and all travel expenses will be covered.

Please note: You must be licensed in the state you are performing the exams in.

Indiana Illinois Iowa Kansas Michigan Minnesota Missouri Nebraska North Dakota Ohio South Dakota Wisconsin Reserve Health Readiness Program [RHRP] was founded to deliver medical and dental readiness services to the United State military by the Department of Defense [DoD]. Through RHRP our service members are required to receive health assessments yearly. This organization serves the U.S. Army, Army National Guard, U.S. Navy, U.S. Marine Forces, U.S. Air Force Reserve, U.S. Coast Guard, Air National Guard. Our partnership with this organization aligns perfectly with our company values allowing us to give back to our reservist community.

We are currently looking for additional General Medicine, Audiology, and Optometry providers to give exams through RHRP. Adding RHRP to your contract is a great way to enhance your healthcare offerings. The reservist will come to your office to get an exam. These exams can be "quick fillers" for slower times of the day without adding more reporting time or interfering with current schedules. Exams typically take anywhere from 10 – 30 minutes. Additionally, they do not require treatment, follow-up exams, or prescriptions.

MEDICAL RECORDS: ADVANCED SEARCH

Both **Next Generation Viewer** and **Citrix** tools are available to providers when conducting Medical Record Viewing using specific search words in medical records for DME exams for QTC evaluations.

MEDICAL RECORDS REVIEW ENHANCEMENT: NEXT GENERATION VIEWER (NGV)

Providers are now able to utilize the **Next Generation Viewer (NGV)** application when reviewing medical records. Citrix will also remain an option to review medical records. Please note that **NGV** is not available in Internet Explorer. The preferred browser for this application is Google Chrome. Both Firefox and Safari application support **NGV** as well.

2. Open the "Received" Complete-MRs

3. Review Medical Records

After clicking on "Received" under the Medical Records column the NGV will display in a separate window. Bookmarks will automatically be displayed at the top right corner of the screen.

The following Tools are available to you when reviewing medical records: a. **Bookmarks**- This is the same functionality as in the preceding Citrix application.

i. If you select a page from the bookmarks, the bookmarked word will not highlight on the selected page. To find the word on the page more easily, you can use the search function and it will highlight the word on the selected page.

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b. **Menu Icon**- If you would like to expand your record viewing pane, click the "Menu" icon to hide the bookmarks or change the thumbnail settings.

c. **Advanced Search**- Above Bookmarks you will see a "Menu" Icon when you select it you will see "Advanced Search" as an option.



- i. In the search text field, you can search an exact word or part of another word. Then click on the "Go" button.
- ii. Under Search Results: It will display the word you are searching and display five words preceding the search word. When selecting the searched word, it automatically takes you to it in the document.

- iii. The Search word will be highlighted. Searches are now completed in seconds.
- iv. You can copy and paste the selected text from the Medical Record to the worksheet.

d. Thumbnails- The thumbnails are similar to the preceding Citrix application.



i. Thumbnail Size- Ability to zoom in on thumbnails

ii. Number of columns - Expandable pane for viewing multiple thumbnails. Click and drag the dot for the desired number of thumbnail columns.

iii. Apply – Press the apply button to see and implement "Thumbnail Size" and "Number of Columns" settings.

- e. **Copy & Paste Functionality** Click the "T" and you will be able to highlight and copy the text.
 - i. You cannot right-click to copy in this application; you will have to use CTRL+C to copy text.
- f. **Zoom In / Zoom Out** You can use this to zoom in or out on pages of medical records.
- g. Rotate Single Page- Rotate individual pages within the medical record.
- h. Word Search- Use single words to search in the medical record. No quotation marks are needed for multiple word/phrase searches.
 - i. When doing searches, if the text box becomes outlined in red, the search has been completed and there are no more occurrences of the word/phrase that you have searched.



If you accidentally logged in and launched the MRV, you can either use the MRV to search records using Citrix or you can close the window to access the NGV Medical Records. To close the MRV:

a. Click on the "x" in the top right corner of the MRV b. When prompted select "Leave this Page"

> NOTE: If you are using Internet Explorer, the NGV will not be available, and you will need to review records through the MRV/Citrix application. This window will need to remain open to review records in Internet Explorer.
